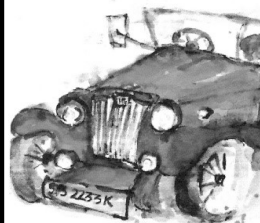

## ***LAST CHANCE TO SIGN UP FOR THE*** **FALL COVERED BRIDGE TOUR** **OCTOBER 22, 2016**



Hello, our Corvair Club is going to tour a few covered bridges in Perry County on October 22<sup>ND</sup>.

We will meet at Curt and Jane Bonser's house between 10:15 a.m. and 10:45 a.m. Plan to pull out at 10:46 a.m. Below are directions to our house from US 15. We live in a retirement community, Bethany Village. I think we will be back in Mechanicsburg by 3:00 p.m. or 3:30 p.m. in time to get home before the moon rises and deer are running across the roads.

**Please let me know no later than October 1<sup>ST</sup> if you are coming.** Our lunch reservations at the restaurant requires a head count on how many will be eating. ### **DIRECTIONS TO CURT AND JANE'S HOUSE:** (Starting point of the Covered Bridge Tour)

The directions below are from the US-15 exit at the ROSSMOYNE/WESLEY (Wesley/Rossmoyne) exit:

- **Coming FROM the NORTH:** Wesley/Rossmoyne exit is the Third exit south of I-581 on US-15, Take the Wesley/Rossmoyne exit, keep right on to Wesley Dr. Turn right at the third traffic light. About 100 ft. after the right turn into Asbury Bethany Village, turn left, this will look like you are turning left into a parking lot, but it is a street. Go past the second stop sign, turn right onto Albright Dr. Our house is the third house on the right, 511 Albright Drive, Mechanicsburg, PA, 17055.
- **Coming FROM the SOUTH:** on Rte. 15, Wesley/Rossmoyne exit is the first exit past the PA. Turnpike (1/2 mile) while traveling north on US-15. Exit off US-15 at the Rossmoyne/Wesley exit. Turn left on to Wesley Drive, at the fourth traffic light turn right. The right turn at the fourth light goes into the east side of Asbury Bethany Village retirement community. About 100 ft. after the right turn into Asbury Bethany Village, turn left (this will look like you are turning into a parking lot, but it is a street. Go past the second stop sign, turn right onto Albright Dr. Our house is the third house on the right, 511 Albright Dr., Mechanicsburg, PA 17055.

### **BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE TOUR:**

- 1) **Landisburg ... Kennedy Valley Bridge/Rice Bridge** *36 minutes, 23 miles (time and mileage source from AAA)*
  - \* Stop at Silver Spring Church Cemetery, no Corvairs six feet under. Just a quick stop for history sake.
  - \* Village Square Dinner for lunch stop...Shermans Dale, PA.
  - \* Rice Covered Bridge. Built by Zackery Rice in 1869...reconstructed 2003...132 ft. x 18 ft. with 2-inch planking 16 ft. long. Window openings are Burr arch truss and queen post truss construction.
- 2) **Waggoner's Covered Bridge** *9 minutes, 5.5 miles*
  - \* Built by Joseph D. Lightner in 1889. 84 ft. x 17 ft. with planking 15 ft. x 3 inches. Burr Arch truss construction.
  - \* Waggoner's bridge will be on the RIGHT JUST AS WE CROSS A BRIDGE ON THE STATE HIGHWAY. This is not a safe bridge stop for us due to restricted view when returning to the state highway.
- 3) **Cisna Mill Covered Bridge/Adair's Bridge** *6 minutes, 3.6 miles*
  - \* Builder unknown, built in 1864 and the oldest Covered Bridge in Perry County. 150 ft. x 14 ft. with 3 inch planking laid cross wise. In 1919 it was steel I-beam reinforced. Burr Arch Truss construction.
- 4) **Brooks Bridge/Kauffman's Bridge** *11 minutes 6.7 miles (will drive through Blane, PA)*
  - \* Builder unknown, built in 1883, demolished in 2003, a replica rebuilt 2004. 70 ft. x 17 ft. planking; 14 ft. x 2 inches steel I-Beam reinforced. Burr Arch construction and King Post in original construction.
- 5) **New Germantown Bridge** *6 minutes 3.1 miles (Jackson, PA, 3003 route, left)*
  - \* Built by John W. Fry in 1891. 74 ft. x 12 ft. with planking 2 inches by 16 ft. Multiple King post, and Queen post trusses.

**NOTE:** We will stop in Blane, PA. at the Blane Family Restaurant for a rest stop and ice cream (regular cones and waffle cones). They only have hard ice cream. Rest room facilities available.

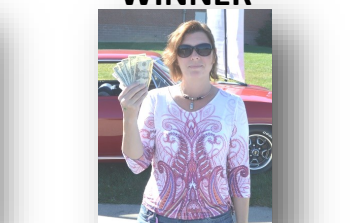

# Corvair **Cooks** Corner

## TRISHA YEARWOOD'S BLUE RIBBON MEATLOAF

### Step 1:

#### BISCUIT DOUGH

##### Ingredients:

- 4 tablespoons vegetable shortening
- 2 cups self-rising flour, plus extra for dusting
- 3/4 cup well-shaken buttermilk

##### Directions:

Using a pastry blender or two table knives, cut the shortening into the flour in a medium bowl until it resembles coarse meal. Use a fork to stir in the buttermilk to make a soft dough, or until the dough comes together and leaves the sides of the bowl. Continue stirring with a fork until all the flour is worked into the dough, and then turn the dough onto a lightly floured board, and then turn the dough onto a lightly floured board and knead three or four times until smooth and manageable.

### Step 2:

#### MEATLOAF

##### Ingredients:

- 1 pound lean ground beef
- 1 tablespoon onion, minced
- 1 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper
- 1/3 cup self-rising flour
- 2 cups canned tomatoes, drained with juice reserved
- 1 3/4 cups frozen peas, thawed
- 1 recipe biscuit dough

##### Directions:

Preheat the oven to 450 degrees F. Grease a baking sheet with cooking spray.

Combine the beef, onion, salt, and pepper in a large skillet and cook over medium heat until the meat is browned, 12-15 minutes. Remove from the heat. Stir in the flour and 1/3 cup of the reserved tomato liquid. Remove 1 cup of this meat mixture and set aside. Add the tomatoes, crushing them with your hands as you add them, and the peas to the skillet. Set aside.

### Step 3:

On a well-floured surface, roll the biscuit dough into a large rectangle about 1/2 inch thick. Spread the reserved cup of meat mixture thinly over the dough, then roll the dough like a jelly roll, beginning from one long edge. Place the roll on a creased baking sheet. Using kitchen shears or a very sharp knife, cut 1-inch slices almost through to the bottom of the roll. To expose some of the filling, pull alternate slices to the left and right. Bake for 15 minutes or until browned.

Reheat the beef and vegetable mixture. Slice the baked loaf and spoon some of the hot vegetable and meat mixture of each slice.



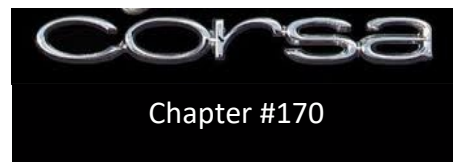
## Central Pennsylvania Corvair Club
